- Accommodation neither pupils nor teaching staff can guarantee to have private, uninterrupted time in the school week in which to have a lesson.
- Teaching Union Guidance the major teaching unions have advised their members not to participate in live streaming lessons.

But just because we're not all in the same building, doesn't mean we can't have some fun together! Your children will have lots of activities they can get stuck into over the summer term — so keep a close eye on our school website, Twitter, and Facebook.
